The BC Services Card is here!



- Launched 15 February 2013
- 258,000 issued to-date and being used as CareCard replacement
- 4.5 million to be issued over next 5 years



BC Services Card – 3 Types

Identity Assurance Level 3 (HIGH):

Substantiated Claim (high confidence in identity claim)

1. Combo Card

(Driver's Licence & BC Services Card)

2. Photo Card

(Standalone BC Services Card)

Identity Assurance Level 1 (LOW):

Unverified Claim (no to some confidence in identity claim)

3. Non-Photo Card

(Standalone BC Services Card)

- For children and exceptional cases






BC Services Card Features






Role of the Chip Technology



- Does not contain a person's information
- Used as a type of secure digital authentication credential
- Uses payment card industry technology for cryptographically secure validation and identification of the chip itself
- Chip is linked to information registered and held in provincial identity information services program
- Digital services do not interact with the chip, do not get answers from the chip




BC Services Card Program: Issuance

- Cheaper and easier than custom ID-proofing & authentication


For Government

Not Enrolled Yet?

Enrolling for medical coverage is mandatory for B.C. residents.

STEP 1: You must register for MSP to get your Personal Health Number (PHN) on your CareCard.

STEP 2: Register for drug coverage through Fair PharmaCare.

Haven't registered yet? Coverage begins immediately if you register by phone or online.




